

JOB DESCRIPTION

Equipment Maintenance Technician

Essential Job Functions (duties & responsibilities):

- 1. Maintain furnaces and supportive equipment by completing preventive maintenance schedules.
- 2. Troubleshoot and restore, repair, rebuild, or replace faulty or inoperative components and parts.
- 3. Collaborate with other departments, vendors, and contractors to ensure preparation of equipment for temperature uniformity surveys and other outsourced maintenance procedures.
- 4. Plan, complete and troubleshoot the installation of major equipment and furnaces as a key member of a crossfunctional team.
- 5. Perform occasional facilities maintenance related tasks and repairs.
- 6. Able to perform all functions of Heat Treat Operators including:
 - a. Operate, control and monitor heat treating and related equipment.
 - b. Prepare customer supplied parts for processing.
 - c. Load and unload furnaces, bins, baskets, fixtures, etc.
 - d. Follow written procedures on shop orders and/or customer paperwork.
- 7. Assist with production needs when feasible and practicable.
- 8. Bring any irregularities or non-conformities to attention of supervisor or management.
- 9. Promote safety and good housekeeping practices.
- 10. Perform other tasks as assigned or dictated by position.

Requirements:

- 1. Experience with the following a plus:
 - a. High-temperature furnaces: electrically heated or combustion
 - b. Furnace atmospheres: endothermic, dissociated ammonia, etc.
 - c. Vacuum pumping systems: roughing, booster, diffusion, etc.
 - d. Induction heating systems
 - e. Quenching systems: oil, water, polymer, gas
- 2. Language Skills: Must be able to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing.
- 3. Must be able to regularly lift up to 50 lbs, bend, climb, stoop and stand.
- 4. Work Environment: regularly exposed to heat, dust, noise, humidity, fumes, etc.
- 5. Must have the aptitude to learn basic knowledge of heat treating processes, testing, metallurgy, temperatures, etc.
- 6. Must be able to obtain and maintain a forklift operator certification, with training available in-house.
- 7. Must have the ability to report for work on time, follow directions, interact effectively with co-workers, understand and follow rules and procedures and accept constructive criticism.
